The Ella Foard Foundation for Rett Syndrome was created in 2009 to help fund research for the treatment and cure for Rett Syndrome. Ella, the daughter of John and Nalisha Foard, was diagnosed with the disorder on January 10, 2008. John and Nalisha went to work on making a difference in the life of not only their own daughter, but the thousands of children worldwide by increasing the public’s awareness of Rett Syndrome. John shared his cause with Braun Racing and car owner Harry Scott, Jr. generously donated a spot on the decklid and his new young driver, James Buescher, to promote the cause.

Rett Syndrome is a unique developmental disorder that is first recognized in infancy and seen almost always in girls, rarely in boys. Rett Syndrome has been most often misdiagnosed with Autism, cerebral palsy or non-specific developmental delay. Striking all racial and ethnic groups, Rett Syndrome occurs worldwide in 1 of every 10,000-23,000 female births. Ultimately, Rett Syndrome causes problems in brain function that are responsible for cognitive, sensory, emotional, motor and autonomic function. These can include learning, speech, sensory sensations, mood, movement, breathing, cardiac function and evening chewing, swallowing and digestion.

Buescher, one of NASCAR’s hottest rookies, is coming off of a third and second-place finish in his last two NASCAR Camping World Truck Series starts. Under the direction of experienced Braun Racing crew chief, Stewart Cooper, Buescher will make his third start of 2010 for Braun Racing in the No. 10 AccuDoc Solutions Camry.

“It’s always special to bring awareness to a great cause like The Ella Foard Foundation for Rett Syndrome,” said James Buescher. “We have such a great opportunity to be on a stage that allows us to get the word out about a terrible disorder.
